After a few minutes of brainstorming ideas we agreed to put a baby crib in the back of the Sanctuary, publicize our project in our newsletter, with a Minute for Mission, and by word of mouth and see what happened..

Within a few weeks the crib was filled with

- 43 Sheets
- 16 Baby Blankets
- 56 Onesies
- 5 Sleepers
- 44 Baby Caps, many hand knitted
- 10 Miscellaneous baby Items
- 5 Generous donations of money to ship the items

The items have now been sent and the members of our congregation thanked. It was an outpouring of love, and without the find of those two filled black garbage bags we never would have started this new Mission Project.
