David grew up the son of Presbyterian missionaries and started studying classical guitar in the seventh grade. A year later, he was writing his own songs and had made his first recording. From Lebanon to Germany, from grade school to college, from street musician to an ensemble that toured throughout Central and Eastern Europe before putting away his guitars and entered 'corporate America'. Then on July 4<sup>th</sup> 1996, he was diagnosed with a malignant brain tumor and that he would not live until Christmas. He stopped working to pursue treatments and recovery. Rather than return to his corporate job, he returned to his first love of songwriting and performing. His goal is to share the hope on which his life depended. Since making that decision 11 years ago, he has made 16 albums and performed hundreds of concerts in 44 states. David, his songs and his ministry are alive and well.
